EXTERIOR FEATURES

BUILDING: The building is clad in gypsum fiber reinforced concrete, fabricated by Unlimited Designs in Salt Lake City, Utah, and installed by Allens Masonry. A dolomite aggregate from the Tooele Valley is being used in the admixture.

DESIGN MOTIFS:

- Salt grass and lupine flower incorporated in exterior stone, font bowl and millwork
- Cliff rose incorporated in millwork, rugs, decorative paint, font railing and glass art
- Lupine flower incorporated in exterior stone, paint, lighting, millwork and art glass

EXTERIOR ART GLASS: The temple's exterior art glass was designed by FFKR Architects and was fabricated by Holdman Studios in Lehi, Utah. The glass features lupine, cliff rose and grasses native to the region.




